


Crooked Lane Beer Dinner



Beaujolais Nouveau

Le Beaujolais Nouveau est arrive! (The new Beaujolais has arrived!) Celebrate the arrival and tradition at La Provence! Beaujolais is a region in France, just south of Burgundy. It is made up of 12 appellations. The wine is made from Gamay grapes, grown in the Beaujolais region and released the same year of its harvest. Bottles of the current year are officially released on the third Thursday of November. The wine is fresh, fruity, and very low in tannins. It will consist of bright, fresh, red fruit flavors such as cherry, strawberry and raspberry and will be delivered to your palate with a distinct zing. This is a wine to pour and celebrate with.
